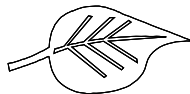


The Restaurant at Convict Lake

In 1871, six of 29 hardened convicts took refuge here after escaping from the Nevada State Penitentiary in Carson City. Along their murderous trail they robbed and killed a mail carrier, William Poor. A posse of men from Benton and what is now Aurora ghost town, led by Robert Morrison, pursued them to this area. After an intensive gunfight, Morrison was killed. (Mount Morrison, over 12,000 feet tall, was named to honor him.)

Although half of the convicts escaped after the gun battle, three were caught in Long Valley. Of these, two were hanged and the other sent back to prison. The entire unfortunate incident led to the ironic naming of this beautiful area which became known as Convict.

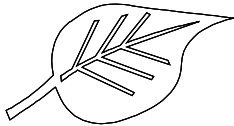
